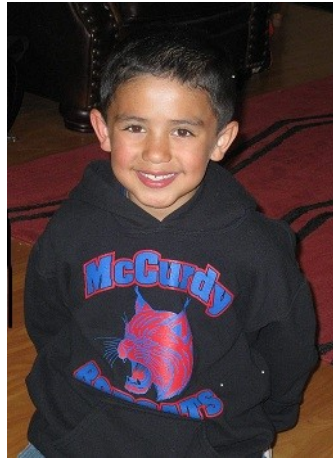


# Robert 'White Mountain' Sanchez
