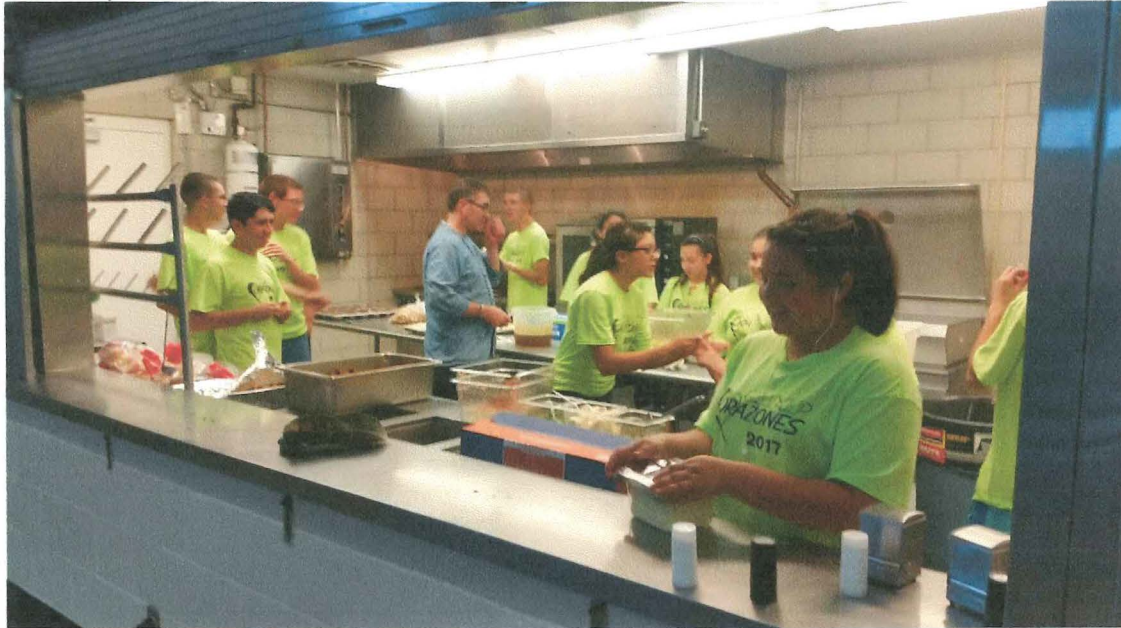

EVHS ROTC Cadets volunteering in the kitchen at Camp Corazones. Courtesy photo.

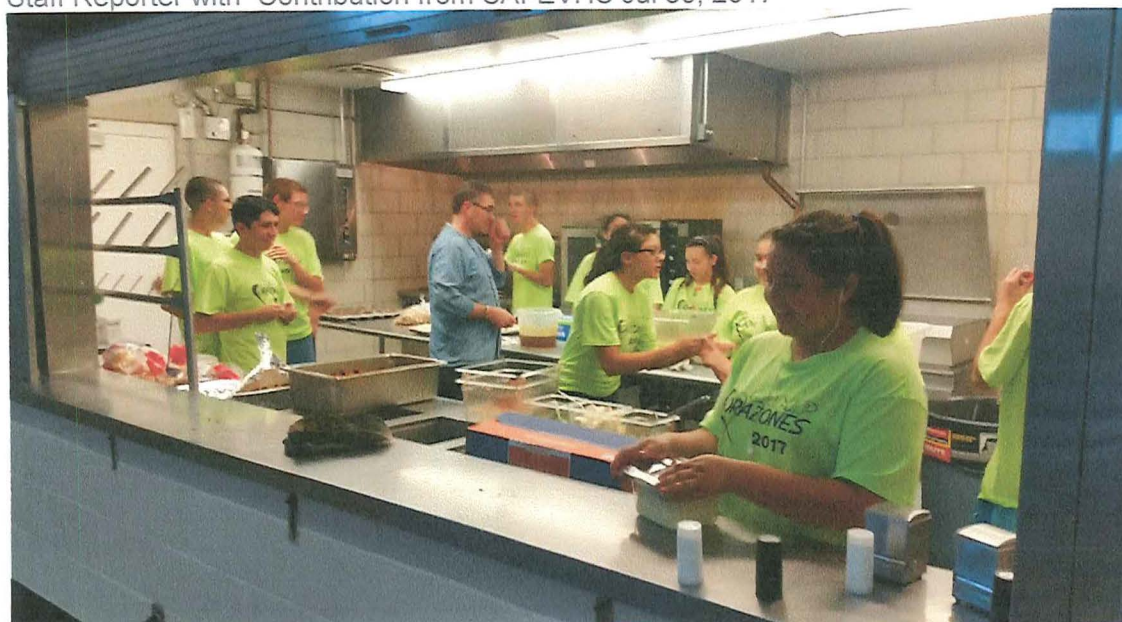
EVHS ROTC Students Volunteer For Kids With HIV/AIDS
