

1st period Tardy Policy

The following Tardy Policy will go into EFFECT ON August 27th, 2018

Definitions:

- Tardy: Not being in class when the Tardy bell rings at 7:55 am
- Absence: Arriving more than 15 minutes after bell
- Chronically Tardy: Arriving Late 5 or more times to school for *any reason* excused, or unexcused. This is an indication that a student is academically at risk due to missing too
- Three tardies = one absence

3 Unexcused Tardies

- 1 Week Parking Permit Suspension
- 1 Lunch Detention Session

5 unexcused Tardies

- 1 Week Parking Permit Suspension
- 2 Lunch Detention Sessions

7 Unexcused Tardies

- 1 Day Saturday Intervention
- 2 Weeks Parking Permit Suspension

10 Unexcused Tardies

- 2 Day Saturday Intervention
- 1 month Parking Permit Suspension

For Each day after 10 unexcused Tardies, an additional day of Saturday School is added with Year End Parking Permit Suspension.

Failure to comply with the late Arrival Policy consequences may result in referral to the Children, Youth, and Families Department (CYFD- Child Protective Services Division and/or Juvenile Justice Department) for investigation and potential prosecution by the District Court of the State of New Mexico.

If you choose to park on campus while your parking permit is suspended your vehicle WILL BE towed.
